FRENCH TROOPS LAND AT SALONIKA.

ATHENS, To-day. (Delayed in transmission.) French troops, landing from five transports at Salonika, Greece, consist of seventy thousand men.

GREEK PROTEST.

PARIS, To-day. France has notified Greece of the arrival of the first detachment of French troops at Salonika.

WILL NOT ASK FOR ARMISTICE.

ROME, To-day. An official denial was made that the Pope intends to ask the belligerent nations to declare an armistice for November 2nd.

NEW APPOINTMENT.

LONDON, To-day. Major-General Sir Archibald Murray, has been appointed Chief of the Imperial General Staff at the army headquarters in London.

MACHINE GUN IMPORTANCE RECOGNIZED.

LONDON, To-day. The British military authorities have recognized the importance of machine guns.

ITALIANS DO GOOD WORK.

ROME, To-day. An official statement issued yesterday by the headquarters of the Italian General Staff, follows:

BERLIN, To-day. The German steamer Swenka was shelled in the Baltic Sea by a British submarine without warning.

SUCCESSFUL RUSSIAN OPERATIONS.

PETROGRAD, To-day. Official: There has been several engagements at the Riga front, north of Dirschalien.

ATHENS, To-day. After Premier Venizelos explained to the Chamber of Deputies the circumstances connected with the landing of the allied troops at Salonika, the Chamber passed a vote of confidence in the Government.

PARIS, To-day. In consequence of the resignation of the Premier and other members of the cabinet the sessions of the Greek Chamber have been adjourned.

LONDON, To-day. Earl Derby, at the request of Lord Kitchener, Secretary of War, has undertaken the direction of recruiting for the army.

MILAN, To-day. Germany paid the expenses of the Bulgarian mobilization, according to the Corriere della Sera, as military action by Bulgaria was considered indispensable in encouraging Turkey to continue resistance.

FRENCH TRANSPORTS AT SALONIKA.

PARIS, To-day. French transports arrived at Salonika on Friday night. Troops began landing on Saturday, says Athens despatch.

FRENCH TROOPS BEING FORWARDED.

LONDON, To-day. The landing of additional French troops at Salonika is reported from Athens. Correspondent of Exchange Telegraph Company says a number of transports carrying French troops entered the port of Salonika this morning.
