

Warns Canada of Red Propaganda

IRISH VISITOR DECLARES RADICALS FIND FERTILE FIELD IN IRELAND.

OTTAWA, Oct. 20.—(C.P.)—"Where workmen are disgruntled the menace from Red propaganda is serious," according to H. G. Milson, of County Wicklow, Ireland, who is visiting St. John's. Mr. Milson is interested in industrial relations in the United States and Canada, and during the past three years has been making an extensive study of industrial relations in Europe.

Red propaganda had found fertile ground in Ireland, where James Connolly was an avowed disciple of it, he said. There the recent strike has not been the result of trouble between capital and labor, but had resulted from the dispute between two unions, one outspokenly Red. Red propaganda found root in the great ocean ports and among the transportation companies and public utility workers, where the personal element between employer and employee did not enter to any great extent.

The tide of Red propaganda was bound to come to Canada, Mr. Milson believed. It had now reached almost every other part of the Empire and he saw no way of stopping it reaching Canada.

Mr. Milson's investigations in Europe and America had shown him that when the men employed in an industry were part owners of the industry there was not only increased output and efficiency, increased dividends but also less likelihood of Red propaganda finding fertile soil.
