# DOMINION PARLIAMENT.

Ottawa, April 17.

The House concurred in the address of congratulation to the Queen, upon the recovery of the Prince of Wales.

Mr. Holton questioned the government regarding the appointment of Mr. F. G. Johnston, Lieutenant Governor of Manitoba.
