British Grain Trade.

LONDON, Feb. 3.—The Mark Lane Express, in
its weekly review of the British grain trade,
says: English wheat and barley have each ad-
vanced 6d. The prices of barley are against
wheat. American corn is firm. At today's
market prices wheat is generally in demand
on account of renewed frost. The prices of
English wheat were mostly steady, though the
multitude offered were in poor condition.
Foreign wheat was firm. Californian touched
at 10s. 6d. Russian and Indian were dull. Foreign
grain was in demand. Flat corn was
very scarce and prices rose. Round corn
advanced 6d. Oats were 6d. Beans were 3d.
better. Peas were 6d. higher.
