THE MARKETS

THE LOCAL MARKET.

London, Wednesday, July 30.
Wheat, white, per bu. 80c to 85c
Corn, per bu. 45c to 48c
Barley, per bu. 55c to 60c
Beans, per bu. 75c to 80c
Very little business was done on the market this forenoon. Only fifteen loads of hay were offered, which sold at \$3 to \$3.75 per ton.

WEEKLY REVIEW.

The attendance and the offerings of farm produce during the past week have been fairly large. Small stuff and fruits formed the bulk of the offerings. There was no material change in prices, and sales in most of the lines offered were brisk.
Grain—Not much wheat offered; prices are quoted at \$1.35 per cwt. Oats are in good demand at \$1.47 to \$1.50 per cwt. Hay and straw—During the past week there have been offered 50 loads of hay, which sold mostly at \$3 to \$3.50 per ton. A few of the loads sold as high as \$3.75 per ton; all of the offerings were new hay. Straw is scarce at 25c per ton.
Butter and Eggs—Butter has been freely offered, and the market is good. Prices are a trifle firmer; crocks sell at 15c to 16c, and rolls at 14c to 15c. Eggs continue to be offered in large quantities, and prices are steady, at 13c to 14c per dozen for crates and basket lots.
Vegetables and Fruits—The supply of new potatoes has been large and prices have dropped from 25c to 30c per bu.; present prices are firm, at 25c to 30c per bu.; tomatoes are scarce, at 7c to 8c per bu.; cabbages are more plentiful, at 25c to 40c per dozen.
Fruit—The supply of raspberries and other fruits in season has been large. Prices ranged during the week at 75c per box for black raspberries, and 50c per box for red; apples are a drug, at 75c per bu.; some of the offerings are dear at any price; gooseberries are plentiful, at 40c to 50c per bushel; currants at 10c per quart; red at 4c to 6c per box.
Poultry—The supply has been up to the average, and offerings are chiefly chickens, which sell at 50c to 75c per pair, dressed, and 40c to 50c per pair for live ones; ducks, 75c to 90c per pair for dressed, and 70c per pair for live ducks.
Dressed Hogs—There are very few brought on the market for sale; those that are disposed of are sold on previous orders; present prices are 35c per cwt.
Butcher's Meat—Sales are slow, at the following prices: Beef, 50c to 55c per cwt; veal, 45c to 50c; mutton, 45c to 50c; lamb, 40c to 45c per lb. by the carcass.
Honey finds a slow sale, at 10c per lb. for strained, and 12c for that in the comb.

CHICAGO.

Chicago, July 29.—Bears were in full control of all grain markets most of the day. The wheat market was confined to manipulated options, but the whole grain list in all months went lower under the weight of big receipts and prospects of immense coarse grain crops. Toward the close, however, a reaction set in in most grains and especially in July oats, which had lost 5c. In the end July wheat lost only 1/4c, September wheat 1/2c to 3/4c, July corn 1/4c, September corn 1/2c, and September oats 1/4c. July oats closed 2c higher, and provisions closed 1/2c to 3/4c down. Local receipts of wheat were 332 cars, 25 of contract grade; Minneapolis and Duluth reported 2,000 cars, making a total for the three points of 783 cars, against 712 last week and 705 a year ago. Primary receipts were 1,400,000 bu. against 1,123,000 bu. a year ago. Estimated receipts for tomorrow: Wheat, 205 cars; corn, 125 cars; oats, 200 cars; hogs, 22,000 head.
