AIRMEN ARE WELL STARTED ON LAKE RACE TO DETROIT

*Beckwith Havens Is Still Leading Shipmen, Although
Roy L. Francis Is Rapidly Closing In Upon
Him—Martin Leaves Chicago.*

Chicago, Ill., July 11.—Glenn L. Martin, after many delays, left Chicago in his hydro-aeroplane at 7:50 o'clock this morning on the 900-mile race around the lakes to Detroit. Martin, a Los Angeles flyer, was accompanied by Charles G. Smith, a Los Angeles pilot.

He made a pretty start and took the air quickly. He planned to dip into Lake Michigan at South Haven and make Macatawa Beach, over a course of 150 miles, a night's flying.

Beckwith Havens left here at 5:30 this morning in his flight to Manistowick. His departure was made easy, Francis leaving for South Haven at 5:15, and early in the morning, and he was here for a few minutes after Havens had left. Francis left here at 8:10 a.m.
