Prices Brought for the Raw Pelts in London.

"There is a demand for small-sized sealskins among furriers for next season's trade, that of 1886-7," said a furrier recently. "At the regular auction sale of pelts held in London on December 2 the following prices were obtained for Alaska skins: Large pups... 22 1/2; Medium pups... 18 1/2; Small pups... 14 1/2."

"The average price of salted sealskins, which are packed in brine and sent to London to be dyed, is about \$15 each. It takes about three skins to make a suitable cloak. The value of the skins is greatly enhanced by the labor bestowed on them in dyeing. A good London dyed skin is worth from \$40 to \$50 in this market. Martin of London, who has the highest reputation as a fur dyer, has the skins put through forty different processes in order to produce the fine black lustered seal now fashionable. Good seal scarves are worth at least \$100. It is economy to pay a good price for the seal, as the success (and hence the price) of the pelts are scorched during the process of dyeing, and the fur wears off easily."
