CUT THE HAY DUTY IN HALF

GOOD PROGRESS MADE WITH THE AGRICULTURAL SCHEDULE. Various Amendments to Increase the Hay Tax Defeated—Potatoes Reduced From 25 Cents to 15 Cents Per Bushel—The Duties on Other Farm Products Not Materially Changed.

WASHINGTON, June 9.—At 10 the tariff bill was laid before the Senate in consideration being resumed at that paragraph of the agricultural schedule reading "Hay 25 cents per ton." Mr. Pettigrew (Rep., S.) moved to insert a new paragraph before the 25 cent one. This was rejected.
