

THE LATE JACOB CLINE

In the death of Jacob Cline, which occurred on September 30th, at the Private Patients Pavilion of the Toronto General Hospital. Warwick Township lost one of its most widely known, and highly respected farmers. Mr. Cline resided on the old homestead on the 4th line east, all his life. He was a Conservative in Politics, a staunch member and liberal supporter of Grace (Anglican' Church, which is situated on his farm. He was also a member of the Oddfellows Lodge, Watford, his brother Oddfellows acted as his pall bearers. Mr. Cline is survived by his sister, Mrs. M. J. Cowan, who resided with him in the home, and Mrs. James Dunkeld of Toronto, also a half brother, Samuel Burchill, of the 4th line east, and a half sister, Mrs. Earnest Crummer, of Windsor. A nephew and niece, Mr. and Mrs. Royden B. Cowan, of Miami, Florida, and Jack and Margaret, children of Samuel Burchill.

The funeral service was held in Grace Church, 4th line east, con ducted by his rector, Rev. R. H. Diehl, of Adelaide, assisted by the Rev. T. B. R. Westgate, of Winnipeg. At the conclusion of the service at the church, the funeral procession, proceeded to the Watford Cemetery, where his remains were laid to rest in the family plot.

Lambton Medical Society Meets in Waford

Interesting Address on Insanity Heard—Health Week Receives Endorsation

The regular October meeting of the Lambton county medical society was held at Watford on Wed-As special speaker, Harvey Clare, superintendent of the Ontario hospital for insane, Toronto addressed the meeting, his subject being "The Range of the general Practitioner in Psychiatric Diagnosis," with special reference to medico-legal work in regard to insane people.

According to Dr. Clare one in 340 persons in Ontario is insane. About 2000 insane people are admitted to the asylums annually. In New York state one in 220 are said to be insane, the larger number being * due to the fact that there are far more organizations seeking the mentally

feeble from the general population.

The medico-legal aspect of the subject was gone into most carefully and was greatly appreciated

by all present. Following these general remarks the speaker spent considerable time in the differential diagnosis on in-sanity. The great majority of insane people in the asylums know the difference between right and wrong, according to Dr. Clare.
