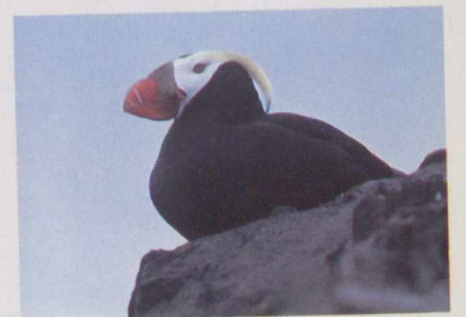

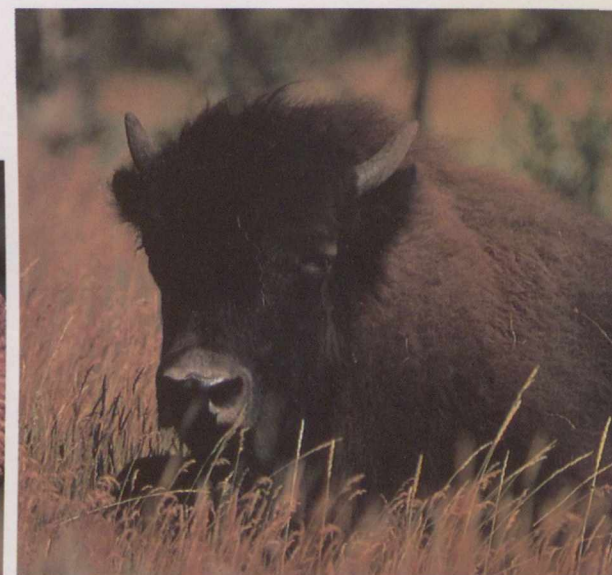
Animals

Banff has grizzlies, black bears, cougars, timber wolves, coyotes, foxes, lynx, moose, elk, woodland caribou, mountain goats, bighorn sheep, deer, grey jays, chickadees, nut hatches, woodpeckers, ravens, bald eagles and golden eagles. Auyuittuq, surrounded on three sides by oceans, has polar bears, walrus, seals, narwhals, porpoises and killer whales off shore; and wolves, barren ground caribou, arctic foxes, arctic hares, lemmings, ermine and weasels on land. L'Île-de-Bonaventure Provincial Park on the Gaspé peninsula has 50,000 gannets, the largest colony in the world, and on a spring day at Point Pelee, on the edge of Lake Erie, a watcher can spot 100 different kinds of birds.
