President of El Salvador

Francisco Guillermo Flores Pérez was born on Oct. 17, 1959. He has an undergraduate degree in political science from Amherst College in Massachusetts and a graduate degree in philosophy from Harvard University.

Mr. Flores taught university in El Salvador for 14 years before beginning his political career as President of the National Assembly. The candidate of the Nationalist Republican Alliance, Mr. Flores was elected President of El Salvador in March 1999. He took office on June 1, 1999. Mr. Flores is married and has two children.

Keith Mitchell

Prime Minister of Grenada

Keith Mitchell was born on Nov. 12, 1946. He attended the University of the West Indies and studied in Washington at Howard and American universities. Mr. Mitchell holds a bachelor's degree in chemistry, a master's degree in mathematics, and a doctorate in mathematics and statistics. A member of the Grenada cricket team for several years, Mr. Mitchell was captain of the team in 1973.

Mr. Mitchell taught mathematics at Howard University from 1977 to 1983. He headed his own consulting firm, Systems Technology and Research Inc., from 1979 to 1984, and served as Minister of Works, Communications and Public Utilities from 1984 to 1989. Mr. Mitchell was elected Prime Minister of Grenada in 1995 and was re-elected in 1999. He is married and has one child.
