Certificate of Appointment to Sub-division B of the Third Division.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of Canada, Chapter 15 of 7-8 Edward VII, intituled "An Act to amend The Civil Service Act," it is amongst other things in effect enacted, that except as therein otherwise provided, appointments to positions in the Inside Service, under that of Deputy Head, shall be by competitive examination, which shall be of such a nature as will determine the qualifications of candidates for the particular positions to which they are to be appointed, and shall be held by the Commission from time to time in accordance with the regulations made by it, and approved by the Governor in Council.

AND WHEREAS Mr. Herbert David Throop, of Ottawa, Ontario, aged twenty-six (hereinafter called the candidate) has been examined under the direction of the Civil Service Commission in open competitive examination, in conformity with the provisions of the Civil Service Act, and of the rules and regulations made thereunder, and has established his fitness for appointment by securing 27th place at the said examination:,

AND WHEREAS the said Civil Service Commission has ascertained respecting the candidate:

THAT he is a British subject and has been a resident of Canada for at least three years;

THAT he is within the limits of age prescribed for the position to which it is proposed to appoint him;

THAT he is free from any physical defect or disease which would be likely to interfere with the proper discharge of his duties;

THAT his character and habits are such as to qualify him for such position; and THAT he possesses the requisite knowledge and ability to enter on the discharge of

his official duties;

Now THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the candidate is qualified to be admitted on probation to the Department of Library of Parliament as a Clerk of the Third Division, Subdivision B. The Librarians of Parliament having reported that exceptional qualifications are required for the performance of the duties of this position, and that it is proposed to make the initial salary on appointment \$700 per annum, the Commissioners accordingly certify, pursuant to the provisions of Section 33 of the Civil Service Amendment Act, 1908, that Mr. Herbert David Throop possesses the exceptional qualifications for the performance of the duties of the position to which he is hereby appointed.
