

to daylight hours only. Those restrictions have been cancelled so that ambulances are now on duty 24 hours a day.

The hon. member mentioned the case of Mrs. Cheechoos: the reports we have on hand state that the fact that transportation was delayed did not cause death.

It must also be remembered that there is no discrimination towards the Indians, since a large number of them, roughly 50 per cent, work for the hospital. We hope to follow closely the administration of those hospitals so that the Indian population will not suffer from delays. I wish to point out that recently
