

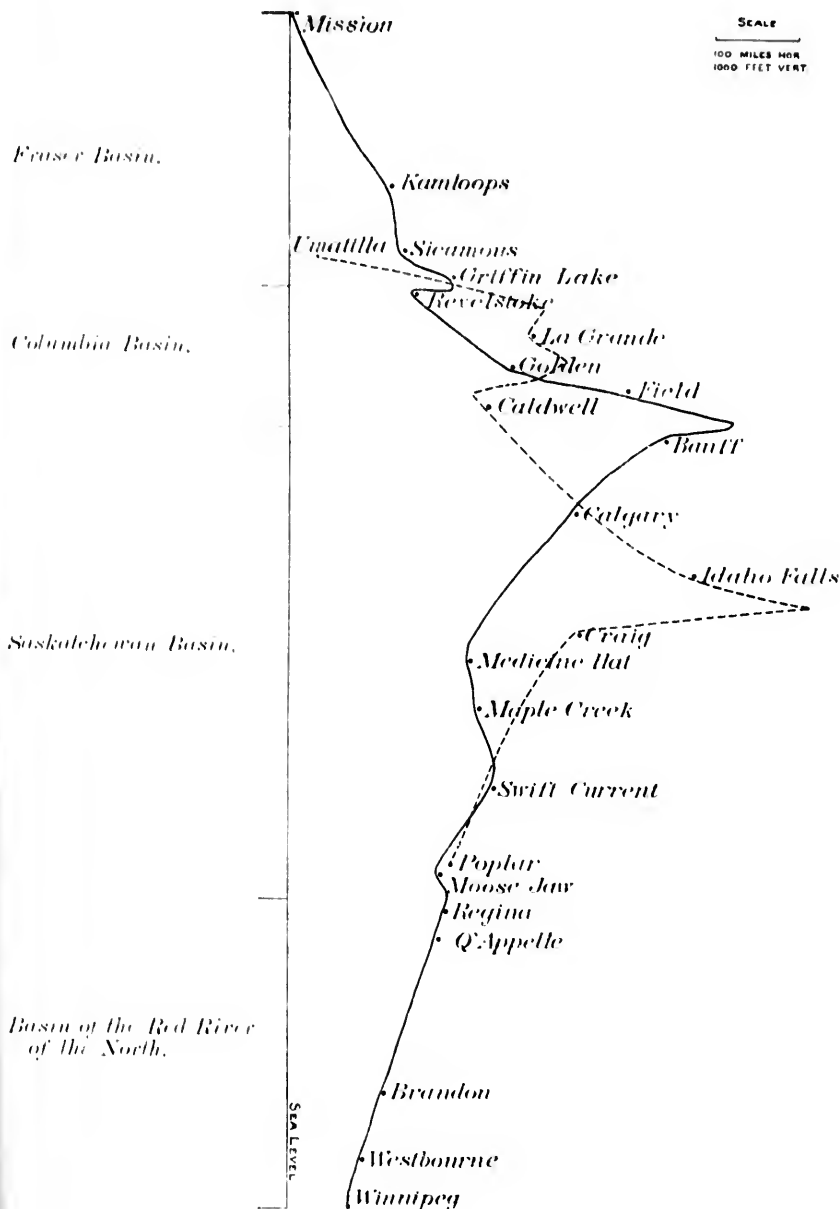
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RELATIVE LONGITUDINAL AND ALTITUDINAL POSITIONS OF THE POINTS WHERE COLLECTIONS WERE MADE

The continuous line represents the Canadian points. The river basins to which these points belong are indicated beneath the sea level. The broken line connects the United States points. All those west of the highest point belong to the Columbia Basin; all those to the right belong to the Missouri Basin.
