

For Grand Marshal.—The same with cross baton and sword.

For Grand Pursuivant. — The same with cross sword and trumpet.

For Grand Tyler —The same with cross swords.

For Provincial Grand Chapters, the same jewels, suspended with a sky-blue ribbon four inches wide.

For County Grand Chapters, the same in silver, suspended with a dark blue ribbon four inches wide.

For Preceptories. the same in silver, suspended with a black ribbon four inches wide.

Past officers' jewels  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches in diameter, to be attached with above colors to the breast.

Past Preceptors.—Gold triangle  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches, with 12 stones, four on each side of triangle, and crown and cross in centre, suspended from a black ribbon  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide by  $2\frac{1}{2}$  in length surmounted by two gold bands with name of Preceptory engraved, and number in centre of ribbon, to be attached to the breast.

Members' Regalia.—A black sash of watered silk,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide, and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  yards in length, with scarlet stripe down sides, and emblems of degrees worn on front. Sash to be worn from right shoulder to left side.
