RESOLVED, That a Set of Maps, Globes, Tables and Seats, Writing Paper, Pens and Ink, and the Weekly Newspapers which the Clerk of this House receives, be placed there for the use of the persons above mentioned; they may also, on requesting it in writing, cause to be brought them in the said apartment and not elsewhere, in order to read and make extracts from them, if they choose to do so, such Volumes in the Library of this House, as they shall have mentioned to the Keeper of the House, to whom they shall return the Volumes which they have received from him, and get back again the written request they may have given, before they go away; with the exception of the "*Tableau de l'Egypte*," "*Guerres des François*," and "British Armour and Heraldry," which shall remain in the Clerk's Room, and shall not be communicated without his consent.
