FREE HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even-numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Territories excepting 8 and 26, which

have not been homesteaded, reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or other purposes, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over eighteen years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section or 160 acres, more or less.

ENTRY. Entry may be made personally at the local land office in which the land to be taken is situate, or if the homesteader desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, or W. F. McCreary, Dominion Immigration Commissioner, Winnipeg, receive authority for some one to make the entry for him. A fee of \$10 is charged for an ordinary homestead entry; but for
