

thereof it shall be lawful for the Justice, Justices or Police Magistrate convicting as aforesaid to issue a warrant under his hand and seal, or in case any two or more of them are acting together therein, then under the hand and seal of one of them, to levy the said penalty and costs, or costs only, by distress and sale of the offender or offenders' goods and chattels, and in case of no sufficient distress to satisfy the said penalty and costs it shall and may be lawful for the Justice or Justices or Police Magistrate convicting as aforesaid to commit the offender or offenders to the common gaol of the said County of Brant with or without hard labor for any period not exceeding six calendar months (except as is provided by the eighth section of this By-Law) unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.

11th—That all By-Laws heretofore passed for regulating public shows and licensing the same are hereby repealed.
