

object and the good government thereof, as expressed in the Law by which it is authorised.

ART. 9. On questions to be decided by a Majority of Votes, the President shall only vote when they are equally divided.

Admittance money and contributions. ART. 10. Every person admitted as a Member of the Society, shall pay on his admission, the sum of Two Guineas, to the Treasurer, to be deposited at the time such person is proposed, and two shillings and six-pence monthly, exclusive of what may from time to time, be agreed upon for the expenses of the house in which the Society meets.

Disposal thereof. ART. 11. There shall always remain in the hands of the Treasurer the Sum of One hundred and Seventy-five Pounds at least, for the payment of the contingent demands on the Society, and the residue of the money shall be lent out at interest agreeably to Law.
