






WHERE WATERS PLUNGE, AND WHITEN.


VIGILANTES OF THE SOUTH.

When the law and order fail, men take the powers of government into their own hands. Such was the case n the early days of the California gold fever, when the business men of 'Fisco organized the Vigilantes to put down the robbers and cut-throats preying on the community, and such was the case in the south in protecting life and property during the "Black Terror." Indeed, a clever writer has picturesquely styled these Ku Klux, 'the Vigilantes of the south." Secrecy was the keystone of their success. The order was ruled from Memphis by a grand wizard of the invisible empire, the late General Nathan Bedford Forth rest. 
