In compliance with the request contained in your Circular 14 & dolet the 11th inst., regarding provisions made for protection against fire, I have the honor to report us follows:

1. There is a tank, of a capacity of 1800 Ballons, near the laundry; we could not keep it full in the winter, owing to the well, from which the water is supplied, not being large enough, but we have just completed the digging of a well 6×6 ft x 28 ft. deep, from which we hope to get an abundant supply of water.

2. There is a force pump in the laundy, used to fill up the boilor in the Kitchen, but it is not powerful enough to throw up a stream of water, and in asse of fire, the water would have to be carried by hand. It would therefore be whisable to get some chemical engines which the joupoils wall ofserate.

3. 6 50 Ballons barrel is Nept full of worder in the boys building, and there are 6 iron buckets always on hand near by.

4. In the hundry, new the tout, two lawe barrels are Kept bull of water; one dozen buckets are Kept there. The buckets are met Kept bull of water, for the water would freeze in the winter.
