The conditions leading up to this demonstration of Bolshevism were explained by Mayor Hanson in the New York
Sun. He said that two years ago Seattle had 15,000 industrial workers. Today it has 65,000 due to war demands. Two years ago the American Federation of Labor controlled the Seattle unions, but since then the influx of labor from all over the country and from some foreign countries, notably Russia, has brought in a very large radical and I. W. W. element. Under stress of war the unions permitted these ancrehists to join, and working with a definite object they were able to gain partial control of the Central Labor Council and full control of many individual unions.
