British and Foreign.

LONDON, May 5. An engagement took place yesterday between the Government troops and Carlists in Navarre, which resulted, after nine hours fighting, in the capture of the entire insurgent centre.

Don Carlos with a remnant of his followers is retreating into France, and the insurrection is said to be at an end. A despatch from the Hague announces that the entire Dutch Cabinet has resigned.

The Court-Martial of Bazaine will begin during the present month, and is likely to continue till September. A memorial presented to Granville on Saturday, urging the Government to secure a copyright Treaty with the United States, has been signed by most distinguished men of England.

There was an important secret meeting at Washington on Saturday between the President and Members of the Committee on Foreign Relations relative to the Treaty of Washington.

Part of Marshall-town, Iowa, was burned on Saturday: \$300,000 loss.

While narrow-gauge railroads are being projected in all directions, a Mr. Burrus of Wisconsin comes before the public with a scheme for a railroad to be built out into the water about twenty-five feet below the surface for some distance, and then end. It is to be operated with a machine which is even more wonderful than the road, and which will navigate the water as well as traverse the land. When this amphibious locomotive arrives at the jumping-off place at Lake Erie, it is to slide gracefully into the water, and by a slight transposition of its machinery become a steamboat. When it has arrived at Montreal it resumes its character of locomotive, and runs on another broad-gauge road to Lake Michigan, whence it is to take water for Chicago. The machine is to be sufficiently large to carry a vessel of five hundred tons, so that all necessity for ship canals will be done away with. The inventor expects to attain a speed of one and twenty-five miles per hour on the road and twenty-five miles in water. It is probably no one will doubt that a great reduction in the price of freight may be expected when Mr. Burrus gets his broad-gauge road and amphibious locomotive successful operation.
