SIR:

In obedience with your instructions in Letter Number 2502. I re-opened the Timber Question on the Lower French River Reserve. We discussed the matter on Pay Day at Henney Inlet School House.

I obtained the Signatures or marks of all the leading men. In fact there was not a dissenting voice.

I Enclosed the Document to have it filled in. So that the Chief and I can attest to it before a Magistrate. Or Commissioner in the High Courts. I could not induce the Chief to leave home to attest to the document. he has not recovered his normal health since his serious illness of last Spring. If the form is filled out and ready for the Affidavits of the Chief and myself I will have them completed.
