They were so certain of success that certain of the Torle were allowed to state which portion of the tract they wished to hold for their Individual use before they gave up the sum of money required of them Last year a party of men came into the district representing certain land speculation in Frence tupert, These men were staking agricultural lands on a commission of Lifty cents per acre, and their operations extended from Chesley station 45 Miles to the Morth to the Haley of the Clapan. One hundred and fifty miles to the South East; taking in all of the land in the recenity of the three northern Fishing points resorted to by the Tahllan Indians, this action on their part alarmed the Indians and materially hastened they forning the general morement I had a council with serval of the leading men. made a tich to every locality in which staking was done and reported to them that no portion heavy Frests are of frequent occupance June July and lluguest shangers purchased by ulternately
