



# BY AN ORDER OF THE PRIVY COUNCIL

OF THE 23RD OCTOBER, 1868, IT IS  
*Ordered,*

That the OFFICE HOURS to be observed by  
the Officers, etc., shall be from

9.30 A.M. to 4 P.M.,

except on SUNDAYS and Legal Holidays, and  
that on SATURDAYS the hours be from 9.30  
A.M. to 1 P.M., except during the Session of  
Parliament.

By the 31st Vic., Cap. 1, Sec. 6, it is enacted:

"*Fifteenthly*"—The word "HOLIDAY" shall  
include

Sundays.

The Epiphany.

The Annunciation.

Ash Wednesday

Good Friday.

Easter Monday.

The Ascension.

Corpus Christi.
