and if the person interested or purchasing persists in having all packages opened, the inspector shall open the remainder, but the cost of inspection shall be borne by such person, if such remainder is found in the same good condition.

Confiscation of wrongly-marked fruit.

"5. In case the fruit found in any of the packages opened does not correspond with the marks thereon, the inspector shall confiscate it and shall immediately notify the Minister of Inland Revenue, who shall instruct the inspector as to its disposal.

Destruction of fruit unfit for use.

Report by

inspector.

"6. The inspector shall confiscate and cause to be destroyed 10 any fruit which he finds unfit for human use.

"7. Every inspector shall, at the end of every month, make a return to the Minister of Inland Revenue of the quantity of each quality of fruits inspected."
