I have no personal knowledge of the land in question, but I do not hesitate to say that the Minutes of decision under which This reserve is claimed for the Indians is exceedingly vaque; in view, therefore, of the opinion expressed by Mejo Drake, Jackson, and Helmeken and from a knowledge that the Provincial Jovernment will give no assistance in the matter, I cannot advise the Department to contest this question in a Court of law; such a course would entail heavy espense with no reasonable prospect of success.

is of special value to the Indians, neither do I know if any other land is available that would suit their requirements, but with your approval, I will take some convenient of portunity to visit the locality, and will make the best arrangement I can in the matter.
