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As proof that the Govt. was under the impression that we received 2500⁰⁰ last year this year they included an item of 2250⁰⁰ and at same time stated it was a cut of 10% from last year when the fact of the matter is we only received \$2250⁰⁰ last year after 2500⁰⁰ was voted us.

Most purely I am not raising any objection because we are the most appreciative family you ever met. We appreciate every kindness you and any one else has done for us but I am sure you and other members don't mind me asking the question that when we were voted 2500⁰⁰ in 1933 why we didn't receive that amount.

What nicer holiday could you and Mrs. Meighen have than to come up and spend a week end with father and mother when the birds are here. I am sure you

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
