

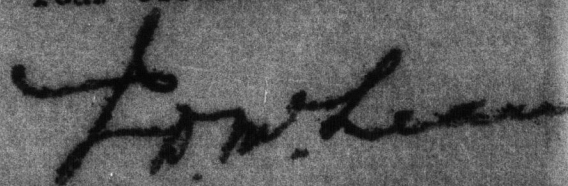

Ottawa, 19th December, 1914.

Madam,-

I am in receipt of your letters of the 30th November and 12th instant, in regard to the payment of \$18.80 made you by cheque No. 1095; and in reply I beg to inform you that your account was paid at the amount at which it was certified by Mr. Parker, Inspector of Indian Agencies, who employed you as stenographer. Mr. Parker allowed the first charge, namely \$6.00 in your account, but reduced the second charge to \$12.80. You were paid for 128 folios of typewriting instead of 190. Mr. Parker is at present absent from Head-quarters. Upon his return your letters above referred to will be brought to his notice.
