AND HAVE LAUNCHED ATTACK OF IMPORTANCE SW FROM BRIDGEHEAD NEAR PERESLAV. THEY ARE ALSO EXTENDING SALIENT WEST OF KIEV BUT POINT OF HEAVILY ARMoured SOVIET DRIVE FROM KIEV WAS PINCHED OFF BY STRONG GERMAN COUNTERATTACKS.

(C) SOUTHWEST PACIFIC. SOLOMONS AREA.

DURING 7-8 NOVEMBER ABOUT 150 OF 300 JAPANESE WHO LANDED NORTH OF EMPRESS AUGUSTA BAY WERE KILLED BY ALLIED GROUND FORCES. OTHERWISE NOTHING TO REPORT.

PART THREE AIR.

(A) MEDITERRANEAN.

8/9 NOVEMBER WELLINGTONS DROPPED 12 TONS ON RR AND RR BRIDGE AT TALAMONE BOSTONS DROPPED 5 TONS FORMIA AND GAETA AS A DIVERSION FOR NAVAL BOMBARDMENT MUSTANGS DROPPED 8 TONS IN AREA NORTH OF ROME ON RR EQUIPMENT AND MECHANICAL VEHICLES 1 E/A DESTROYED. WARHAWKS AND MUSTANGS DROPPED 41 TONS ROAD AND RR BRIDGES AT CEPFRANO AND CASSINO AND ROCCASECCA. WARHAWKS WITH SPITFIRES DROPPED 3 TONS HARBOR INSTALLATIONS AND MERCHANT VESSEL. SPLIT HARBOR. FORTRESSES WITH LIGHTNINGS DROPPED 72 TONS ANSALDO STEEL WORKS AND MARSHALLING YARDS AT GENOA NO HITS OBSERVED ON EITHER TARGET. LIBERATORS WITH LIGHTNINGS DROPPED 60 TONS VILLA PEROSA BALLBERARING WORKS. BOMBS FELL TO W AND SW OF TARGET. 1 E/A DESTROYED. RAF ATTACKED ENEMY SHIPPING AND A JETTY AT SUDA BAY.

(B) RUSSIA.

10 NOVEMBER SOVIET A/C ATTACKED ENEMY NAVAL UNITS KERCH STRAIT WHICH WERE ATTEMPTING HALT SOVIET REINFORCEMENTS FOR KERCH BRIDGEHEADS. LITTLE ACTIVITY OTHER FRONTS.

(C) SW PACIFIC SOLOMONS AREA.

9 NOVEMBER ALLIED A/C EFFECTIVELY ATTACKED ENEMY AIRFIELD BALLALE AND KARA. PHOTOGRAPHS SHOW MONIS TO BE THE ONLY ENEMY AIRFIELD SERVICEABLE.

NEW GUINEA-NEW BRITAIN AREA.

9 NOVEMBER ALLIED A/C SUCCESSFULLY BOMBED ALEXISHAFEN DESTROYING 21 GROUNDED A/C AND 14 OF 25 INTERCEPTING ENEMY FIGHTERS.
