This Indian should have been paid long ago by you or your Department as he performed the work, which was done on your instructions, and neither you nor your Department has any right to keep one of these destitute Indians waiting around for a couple of months for a few paltry dollars that is due to him.

Kindly give this matter your immediate attention as I have enough troubles to finance myself and I have no inclination or desire to finance the Department of Indian Affairs.
