IT WAS RESOLVED

THAT the policy of the Board with regard to the various classes of broadcasting stations mentioned hereunder is as follows, viz:

1. NEW BROADCASTING STATIONS OF SMALL POWER

(a) The Board is not opposed to the establishment of new private broadcasting stations of small power, provided each application is examined on its merits and it is shown that there is need for a station in the particular area for which application is made, to give coverage.
