- III. Special Lessons for Lent will be found in the Table of LESSONS PROPER FOR THE FORTY DAYS OF LENT WHICH MAY BE USED IN PLACE OF THOSE APPOINTED IN THE CALENDAR (pages xxxii—xxxiii).
- IV. Lessons for Ember and Rogation Days will be found in the Table of LESSONS PROPER FOR SPECIAL DAYS (page xxxiv).
- V. Lessons for Special Occasions will be found in the Table of LESSONS PROPER FOR SPECIAL OCCASIONS (pages xxxiv—xxxv).
- VI. Lessons for all other days in the year will be found in the CALENDAR (pages xxxvi—lix).
- VII. On occasions approved by the Ordinary, other Lessons may be substituted for those appointed.
- [VIII.] If any of the Holy Days for which Proper Lessons are appointed in the Table fall upon a Sunday, which is the First Sunday in Advent, Easter Day, Whitsunday or Trinity Sunday, the Lessons appointed for such Sunday shall be read; but if it falls upon any other Sunday, the Lessons appointed either for the Sunday or for the Holy Day may be read at the discretion of the Minister.
- [IX.] Note also that the Collect, Epistle and Gospel appointed for the Sunday shall serve all the week after, when it is not in this Book otherwise ordered.
