and retard his mentality, perhaps for years. Be patient with nervous, inefficient, irritable returned men. Remember that these too are wounds. Help them to become normal. Work with them and us to fit our comrades into the national life so that out of the ashes of war there may arise, Phœnix-like, a newer, better Canada which in this spirit may live and thrive and advance to its own great destined end, so long as men continue to love service for the sake of service; so long as men continue to honour the sacrifice of unselfish patriotism.
