

CALENDAR.

The next Academic Year will begin on Thursday, the 12th of August, and will be divided into three terms of fourteen weeks each. The first, beginning on the 12th of August, will close on Wednesday the 17th November. The second Term will begin on Thursday the 18th November and close on Wednesday the 23rd of February 1859. The third will begin on Thursday the 24th of February and close on Wednesday the 1st of June.

ANNIVERSARY EXERCISES.

On the last day of the Academic Year, Wednesday, June 1st, 1859.

All who design to become Students in this Institution, should enter, if at all possible, at the commencement of a Term, as the regular classes are then organized; pupils, however, will be received at any time. The only pre-requisites for admission to the Primary Department are a good moral character, ability to read and spell, and age sufficient to enable the Pupil to prepare regularly for recitation.

To ensure the admission of new Pupils at the commencement of the next Term, to either Branch of the Institution, early application should be made.

Students in good standing in either Branch, can receive an honourable dismissal from the Institution, at the end of the Examination at the termination of any term; and at no other time except in special cases.
