one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, that

1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this \$3,220.926.38 Province, there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not appropriated for exceeding in the whole, three millions two hundred and thirty Government, thousand nine hundred and twenty-six dollars and thirty-eight &c., for 1862 and 1861. cents, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, and to make good certain sums expended for the Public Service in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and not otherwise provided for, and for other purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to authorize Loan of the raising, by way of loan on the credit of the Consolidated \$3,000,000 authorized. Revenue Fund of this Province, a sum not exceeding three millions of dollars, to be placed to the credit of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund, lowards making good the sums charged upon the said Fund by this Act, for the Public Service.

3. For the purpose of raising such sum as aforesaid, it shall How to be be lawful for the Governor in Council, to authorize the sale of raised. Provincial Stock, or the issuing of Debentures, or both, to an amount not exceeding in the whole, the sum last aforesaid; and any Debentures so to be issued may be in such form, for such separate sums, at such rate of interest not exceeding five Rate of interest. per centum per annum, and the principal and interest thereon may be made payable at such periods and at such places as to the Governor in Council shall seem most expedient, the said principal and interest being hereby made chargeable upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province.

4. Accounts in detail of all moneys raised, received and paid Accounts to be under this Act, and of the Provincial Stock, or Debentures sold Parliament. or issued under the same, and of the interest thereon, and of the redemption of the whole or any part thereof, and of all expenses attending the raising and payment of the sums, to be raised, received and paid under this Act, shall be laid before both Houses of the Legislature of this Province, at each session

5. The due application of all moneys expended under the Account to Her authority of this Act, shall be accounted for to Her Majesty, Majesty. Her Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors shall be pleased to direct.
