ORDERED, That an Ordinance to Incorporate the Ecclesiastics of the Seminary of *Saint Sulpice* of *Montreal*, to confirm their title to the *Fief* and Seignior of the Island of *Montreal*, the *Fief* and Seignior of the Lake of the Two Mountains, and the *Fief* and Seignior of *Saint Sulpice*, in this Province; to provide for the gradual extinction of Seigniorial rights and dues, within the Seigniorial limits of the said *Fiefs* and Seigniories, and for other purposes, be read a second time at the next sitting day.

RESOLVED, That the Communication made this day by His Excellency the Governor General, and entered on the Journals, in reference to the Reunion of the Provinces of *Lower* and *Upper Canada*, be taken into consideration in a Committee of the whole Council to-morrow.
