The sum of Seven Hundred and Sixty Pounds towards indemnifying the Indemnifying the Governor for Money advanced by him out of the Public Funds of Governor for money advanced this Colony for the General Repair of Roads and Bridges,

II.—The Monies hereinbefore granted shall be paid by the Monies Granted Receiver General, in discharge of such Warrants as may, from time to to be paid under time, be drawn by the Governor for the purposes of this Act; and it shall not be lawful for the Receiver General to pay any Monies out of the Public Funds of this Colony other than such as are granted by this Act, or some other Act of the Legislature thereof: Provided, that any Sums of Money advanced by the Government of this Colony on account of any of the foregoing appropriations shall be deducted therefrom.
