Montreal, May 10.—A survey made by the Montreal Produce Merchants' Association of the stocks of butter, cheese and eggs held by the various firms in Montreal at the end of April gives some interesting figures, and show that while the citizens were paying high prices for eggs, the local dealers were piling up their supplies in cold storage.

GERMAN PROTEST TO THE ENTENTE

Berlin, May 10.—(via Copenhagen)—Matthias Erzberger, of the German armistice commission, yesterday handed a note to the Allied armistice commission at Spa, protesting against the transport to Poland by the way of Danzig by the American Foodstuffs Commission of considerable quantities of medical stores, motor cars, rubber tires, sewing machines and other material destined for the Polish army. The note contends that this is not permissible under existing agreements and concludes by saying that the German government will prevent the dispatch of any further war material.
