The girl was found in an unconscious condition in the rear yard of the home of Mrs. M. Timbrell, corner of Dufferin avenue and Adelaide streets, Tuesday afternoon, and died six hours later at her home without gaining consciousness.

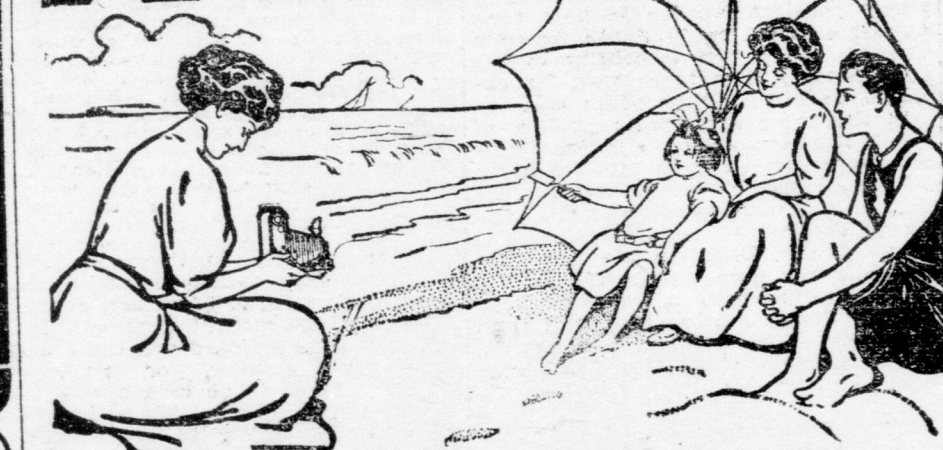
The cause of the dilation is unknown at present, but according to the physicians who performed the autopsy it may have been caused by something eaten by the girl.

FOUR CUBANS SENT BACK TO STATES

Cigarmakers Were Found Guilty of Violating Dominion Immigration Act.

CAME IN BY SARNIA

Entered Canada on an Excursion, Without Baggage, in Order to Deceive Officers.

Felix Tuson, Rafael Mendes Garcia, Damaso Rando and Modesto Lopez, Cuban cigarmakers employed at the Kelly cigar factory, were arrested on Wednesday by Travelling Immigration Inspector Reynolds, of Ottawa, and Wm. Clydale, of Windsor, and charged before Police Magistrate Judd with a violation of the immigration act.

The case was heard in camera on Wednesday afternoon, and the men, after pleading guilty, were ordered deported at 8:20 p.m. The men left Detroit on an excursion without baggage, and evaded the immigration officers at Sarnia.

In some manner the officers at the border learned that the men were coming to Canada and traced their movements from the time they left Detroit.

It was learned that they had kept under cover until they passed the officers at Port Huron. They then came on to London, where they received employment in Kelly's factory.

The men were arrested by Detective Egelton, and after their trial were handed over to the immigration officers, who took them to Detroit on the 8:20 train.
