Toronto Announcement Says Drive to Raise \$4,000,000 Succeeding—One Londoner Contributes \$15,000—Montreal and Toronto Subscriptions Are Large

TORONTO, Feb. 6.—In anticipation of the coming of the Methodist Church to raise \$4,000,000 next week in connection with the inter-church forward movement, it is expected that another \$250,000 will be forthcoming from Hamilton before the next Monday when the drive throughout the Dominion begins.

A message from the Methodist Churches of Canada and Newfoundland, signed by Rev. Dr. S. D. Chown, general secretary of the Methodist Church in Canada; A. E. Ames, chairman of the Methodist National Council; and Rev. Dr. J. H. Epp, general secretary, as follows: "Most encouraging initial success is being reported. We earnestly hope that every single church will exceed its objective, and that a total may be secured of over five million dollars."

MILLERAND DECLARES THAT GERMANY MUST PAY FULL PENALTY

French Premier Says Government Determined to Execute Treaty.

VOTE OF CONFIDENCE

Chamber Approves Foreign Policy—Millerand Hopes for Russian Peace.

PARIS, Feb. 6.—The Chamber of Deputies voted confidence in the cabinet today upon an interpellation with regard to its foreign policy. The vote was 518 to 68. Premier Millerand asserted that the Government was determined to execute vigorously and fully the peace treaty and served notice upon Germany that "all that she owes we will exact."

The premier said he considered that the Germans had flagrantly failed to execute the delivery of coal, which was most important to France, while buying more coal than the French to warm themselves.

M. Millerand declared that he regretted that the United States had not yet ratified the treaty, but remarked that the reparations commission was functioning and "we have no disquietude concerning the final decision of the United States."

NO CONQUEST IN SYRIA. PARIS, Feb. 6.—(Havas).—Premier Millerand declared that France did not intend to pursue a policy of conquest in Syria, and did not intend to menace the population's independence, but declared to establish a good administration in the country and the justice was done.

Referring to Russia, M. Millerand said that the plan for resuming commercial relations with the Russian Empire, the premier asserted that the exports would be under control and if it were found they were being used to revitalize the Red armies, they would be immediately stopped.

He found fault with the Soviet Government, but expressed gratitude to the Russian people and hoped that they would assume their place reserved for them at the peace conference. He declared that France would spare no effort to reach an accord without interfering with the internal policy of Russia. The premier insisted on a Franco-Polish friendship, so that if Poland were attacked, the coalition would be complete.

VON BUELOW ADVISES GERMANS WANTED NOT TO SUBMIT TO REST. BERLIN, Feb. 6.—Field Marshal von Buelow told the Lokai Anzeiger today that Germans whose names are on the list of those whose extradition is demanded by the allies "only did their duty to the fatherland," and that extradition was imminent to which no good German would voluntarily submit.

The field marshal declared he would never place himself at the disposal of the entente nations, and expressed the belief that most of the commanders named in the allied list would take the same view.

It is understood that meetings of army and navy commanders were held on January 7, and it was unanimously concluded that evasion of the extradition clauses of the Versailles treaty was entirely incompatible with German honor, and that no one must voluntarily surrender. Legal objections should be lodged against orders for the arrest of any of the commanders. It was decided at these meetings.

Forced to Give Way. Even if the present Government is forced to give way to a new cabinet, other factors of the entire situation prevail, it is said. It is not improbable that the Government will promptly get into touch with the National Assembly, which is expected to reconvene on February 15, and adjourn until the end of the month.

Persons well informed deny the existence of a government crisis, and the Prussian cabinet has unanimously endorsed the national cabinet's attitude which is unaltered. This may be regarded as a symptom of the spirit in which the entente demands are being met. All prominent politicians opposing the allied edict.

Obtain Modification. It is believed that the Government will attempt to obtain a modification of the peace treaty respecting the extradition of German commanders. It will, so to speak, fold its arms and let events take their own course, according to prevalent opinion. Already it is reported, the German army men detailed to accompany the entente commission of control have refused to perform their duty.

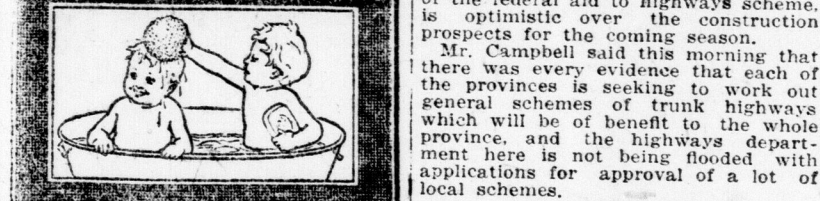

VACCINATION CHECKS SMALLPOX EPIDEMIC. ST. CATHARINES, Feb. 6.—The epidemic of smallpox and diphtheria here are now under control, according to Dr. Curry, medical officer of health for this city. The first 22 cases of smallpox were among children of school age, the M. O. H. stated today, but since compulsory vaccination among school children has been in effect only one child has developed smallpox.

MAKE PRISONERS FIGHT. WASHINGTON, Feb. 6.—The Russian Bolsheviks are recruiting natives and war prisoners into new units, according to information received today by the state department. The Bolsheviks are establishing military bases there as a preliminary, it is said, to a campaign against India.
