## THEY'LL SCOUT ON SMOOTH WATER

Hanlan and Gaudaur sign articles for a Boat Race on July 22, as stated yesterday. The document reads: Articles of agreement between Edward Hanlan of Toronto, Ontario, and Jacob G. Gaudaur of Atherley, Ontario, for a single scull race in best and best boats, for a stake of one thousand dollars (\$1000) a side and the championship of America, on Saturday, July 22, 1939.

The race to be over a course of a mile and a half and return. Mr. John Leacock of Toronto is agreed on as temporary and final stakeholder and Mr. James Douglas of Toronto as referee. The first deposit of \$500 a side is placed with the stakeholder this day.

The second deposit of \$500 a side must be made with the stakeholder not later than Wednesday, March 22; the final deposit must be made not later than Thursday, March 23, completing the full amount of the stakes.

The race to be rowed on smooth water, the referee being sole judge of the condition of the same. The race to be rowed at Toronto or Oshawa if water in Toronto Oshawa for scull race; if rowed at Oshawa, the place to be decided by mutual agreement, the referee, by the referee, at the time of the second deposit, and the expense allowance to be paid one week before the day of the race.

All receipts from whatever source over and above the \$200 to be paid to the referee. The race to take place between the hours of 3 and 7 p.m. on the day stated, and in the judgment of the referee.

The start to be made from boats moored at least 30 yards apart, and to be turned from start to starboard.

The referee shall appoint a judge at the finish, and the contestants shall appoint judges at the turn.

Either party failing to comply with the conditions of this agreement shall forfeit all rights in the stakeholder's hands.

Except where conflicting with the foregoing articles, the laws of boat racing as set forth in the Canadian Association of Amateur Rowers shall govern this race.
