the simplicity with which they disclaim all credit for their heroism. Donna Teresa's dark shadow stalks everywhere, mostly in the distant background, but latterly she steps into the front line where our heroes drink in silence the toast "To the Vengeance of Teresa Saumarez !" The suspense at Chateau Lignac is intense, and at times really terrible, but it is everywhere perfectly sustained. Mr. Drummond will probably never be able to excel some of the spages in the last chapters of the book. Claire de Lignac is as fair a heroine as
