OTTAWA, March 15, 1948.

Sir:

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note dated March 1, 1948, which reads as follows:

EXCHANGE OF NOTES

Conforming to the Agreement of Turkey and the Government of Canada to extend and increase the flow of trade between these two countries, I have the pleasure to propose to Your Excellency on behalf of the Canadian Government, the following Commercial Treaty:

1. Articles, the growth of manufacture of Turkey shall be on importation into Canada, be subject to higher duties or charges than those levied or which may hereafter be levied on like articles, the growth of produce or manufacture of any foreign country.
