

3. The sides will exchange artistic and cultural exhibitions on the basis of mutual interests. In particular, the Canadian side will receive the exhibition of the Russian fine arts of the second half of the XIX century in the leading museums of the country in response to the exhibition of the Canadian artists "The Group of Seven" which was held in the USSR in 1977. During the validity of the programme both sides will continue consultations on further exchange of exhibition of fine and applied arts. The terms will be agreed upon in each particular case by competent Soviet and Canadian organizations.

4. The sides will promote and encourage the exchange of information and publications of mutual interest between museums and art galleries of both countries.

5. The sides will consider favourably requests for the loan of works of art or other items of cultural value for display in exhibitions held in each of the countries.

6. The sides will promote the exchange of books, textbooks and other school supplies, periodical literature and information material between libraries, archives and other corresponding institutions of the Soviet Union and Canada on the basis of reciprocity in accordance with the regulations in effect in each country.
