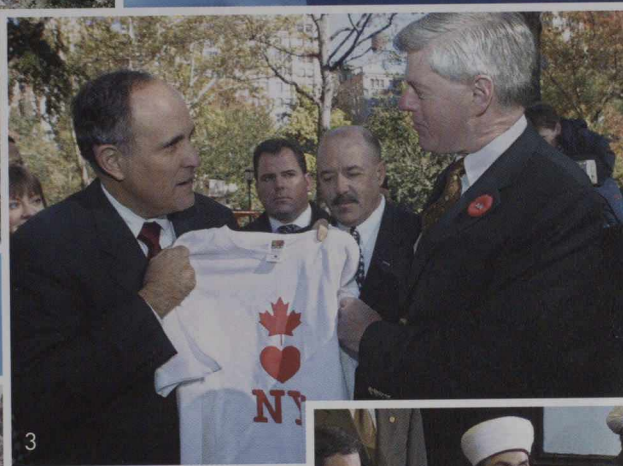


Shoulder to Shoulder
