THE CANADIAN DELEGATION TO THE TWENTY-THIRD SESSION OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL OF THE UNITED NATIONS, WHICH WILL BE HELD IN NEW YORK FROM APRIL 16 TO MAY 3, 1957, WILL BE HEADED BY DR. R. A. MACKAY, PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CANADA TO THE UNITED NATIONS IN NEW YORK.

HE WILL BE ASSISTED BY AN ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE, MR. JEAN BOUCHER, DIRECTOR OF TECHNICAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION, AND BY OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENTS OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS AND AGRICULTURE.

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL (OR ECOSOC) HOLDS TWO REGULAR SESSIONS EACH YEAR. CANADA IS AT PRESENT SERVING A THIRD TERM AS MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL, TO WHICH IT WAS ELECTED FOR THREE YEARS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1956.
