Mr. Lamber (Edmonton West): Mr. Speaker, I rise on a point of order. On the last occasion I drew to the attention of the House the increasing habit of the government of asking that certain questions be made orders for returns and that the answers be tabled. I protest on behalf of the members of this House against this practice without stating the reason for it. It used to be and has been the practice for such answers to be tabled only if they were a compilation from several departments or if it was stated that the answer was too long and too detailed to be printed in *Hansard*. Other than for those reasons, the House should not give its acceptance to the proposal.

Mr. Reid, Mr. Speaker, I think I should explain to the House the reasons for this practice. The order was put into the standing order because the size of *Hansard* was getting out of all proportion as the result of the answers that were printed. The general practice we follow now is that all answers that will take over half a page to three quarters of a page in *Hansard* are made orders for return. I might say that the original decision to table was not taken by me but one that has grown up over the years since the standing orders were changed to permit the automatic tabling of these answers. We have a very real problem in terms of the production of *Hansard* and also, because of the type of questions that members are asking, we now find that the type of answers the departments are asked to supply are growing in volume, and hence I
