

Memorandum concerning the visit of H.R.H. the Prince of  
Wales.

His Royal Highness will arrive in Montreal about mid-day on October 27th and will proceed to the City Hall where an address will be presented to him by the Mayor. The actual disposal of the rest of the time on this day has not yet been determined, but it has been suggested that a public reception be tendered to His Royal Highness in the evening.

October 28th. will be Soldiers' and Sailors' Day. He will visit the Harbour in the morning, and probably lay the corner stone for the Sailors' Memorial. He will inspect a large parade of returned soldiers in the afternoon, and there will be a military dinner for him in the evening.

October 29th. His Royal Highness will leave Montreal early in the morning for Sherbrooke and will return in the evening. It is possible that a dinner may be given to him in the evening.

October 30th. He will visit the Khaki Club and certain other institutions in the City. He will attend a Convocation at McGill University where he will receive an honorary degree. He will probably also attend a Convocation at Laval University which will confer upon him a like honour. There will be a dinner, reception or ball in the evening.

October 31st. He will leave Montreal in the morning, possibly by motor, and will visit Macdonald College, arriving in Ottawa in the afternoon.
